- 1) In which different ways can you relate to the man with leprosy?
- 2) Have a read of Leviticus 14. How does the wording (eg v19) show that leprosy was more serious than simply a disease?
- 3) It's a bit strange that Jesus tells people not to spread the news about who he is (we saw it in 1:25 and 1:34). What does Peter get right in 8:27-33 and what does he get wrong? So what kind of a King does Peter think Jesus is? Do you think that this is the reason that Jesus doesn't want everyone realising he's God's Messiah (because they might have wrong expectations of what he brings)?
- 4) How might we also think Jesus is the King, but get wrong what kind of King he is? What will adjusting our thinking mean for your life Mark 8v34-38?
