- 1) Do you agree that our sin is our biggest problem? What instead are you tempted to think is your biggest problem? What would happen if we get all the issues in our life sorted, but not the forgiveness of our sin?
- 2) Look up Daniel 7:9-13 to understand more about what a big thing it is for Jesus to be called the "Son of Man". How does this increase your understanding of a) why the teachers of the law were concerned? b) Jesus as fully God, fully man?
- 3) Are you convinced (v10) that Jesus has authority on earth to forgive sins... your sins? Further to Mark 2, How do the following passages difficulties prove it:
 - a) 1 Cor 15v3-5 b) Hebrews 10:11-14 c) Galatians 3:14-15
- 4) "Only when we see that see that sin is our greatest problem, will we see that Jesus is the only solution". When you are overcome with problems in life, how does this passage give you perspective?
