Dig Deeper into Mark 4:1-20 for personal study and Life Groups...



Here are some questions to think more deeply about the passage from the sermon for yourself or in small groups this week...

- 1. Where do you see rejection so far in Mark's gospel? How does this set the scene for the parable of the sower?
- Remind yourself of the four kinds of soil (v1-8) and what they stand for (14-20). How have you seen people respond to the message about Jesus in the different ways symbolised by the four soils? Try to be specific.
- 3. How are you normally affected when other people reject something you are considering? How does this passage help you to react independently and carefully?
- 4. Has your understanding of "parable" been changed by this passage? Do you agree with the analogy that they are like a 'sieve', or can you think of a better analogy?
- 5. How does viewing "perception"/"understanding" (v12) as a "gift" (v11) change the way you approach a) bible reading, and b) outreach? (Do Isaiah 66:2 and 2 Cor 4:4-6 help respectively?)
