




Dig Deeper into Mark 6v1-13 for personal study and Life Groups...

Here are some questions to think more deeply about the passage from the sermon for yourself or in small groups this week...

1. Look up a few things that are “amazing” in Mark’s gospel: 1:22, 2:12, 5:20, 7:37, 12:17, 15:5. How does 6:6 stand out?!
2. Do you have any experience of people looking like they are responding positively to Jesus but then they ultimately reject him? Why did they change (see also Mark 4:17)?
3. We are not Jesus or the 1st Century apostles, so we may not experience things exactly as they did but how do these passages help manage our expectations in Christian mission? Apply that to our Christmas outreach (but remember also Mark 4:20)!
4. How might these passages help us understand aspects of the disciples’ mission better: Exodus 12:11, Isaiah 52:1-3, Acts 13:51 and 18:6?
5. How would you explain what is the right response to Jesus in your own words (see also 4:20 and 8:34)? Are you responding rightly?
