## Dig Deeper into Nehemiah 9-10 for personal study and Life Groups...



Here are some questions to think more deeply about the passage from the sermon for yourself or in small (zoom!) groups this week...

This is a really long passage, so you might like to look at the overview on page 2 to see how it divides up.

- 1. Choose a section of the prayer to read (from v5-31). For example you might like to focus on v16-21 or v29-31. What specific things does it tell you about God? Which of those do you need to hear right now?
- 2. How does this passage illustrate human nature? Which idols have you discovered you lean on too hard in these recent days (when you turn a "good" thing into a "god" thing)?
- 3. What does it mean for us as a church to "reorientate ourselves back to Jesus, the Light of the World" at this time? Noting the specific pledges in v30-39, what are equivalents for you that you need personally to commit to?
