- 2. How do each of these New Testament references to the Psalm help us understand the Psalm more and what it means today for those who have taken refuge in Jesus?
 - a. Acts 4:23-30
 - b. Mark 9:7
 - c. Revelation 2:26,27

(those who want to can also look up Rev 19:15 and Hebrews 1:5 & 5:5 later)

3. How might this Psalm affect a) your view of Jesus, b) your prayers?

Finish your time by saying the Psalm together out loud.


