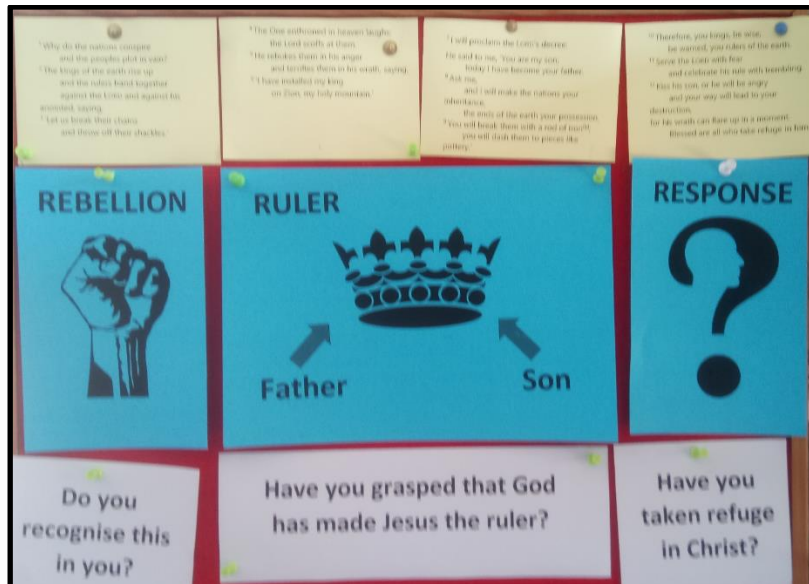


## Dig Deeper Psalm 2 for personal study and Life Groups...



Start with a prayer and read the Psalm a couple of times...

1. How do each of the 4 paragraphs flow into one another?
2. How do each of these New Testament references to the Psalm help us understand the Psalm more and what it means today for those who have taken refuge in Jesus?
  - a. [Acts 4:23-30](#)
  - b. [Mark 9:7](#)
  - c. [Revelation 2:26,27](#)

(those who want to can also look up Rev 19:15 and Hebrews 1:5 & 5:5 later)

3. How might this Psalm affect a) your view of Jesus, b) your prayers?

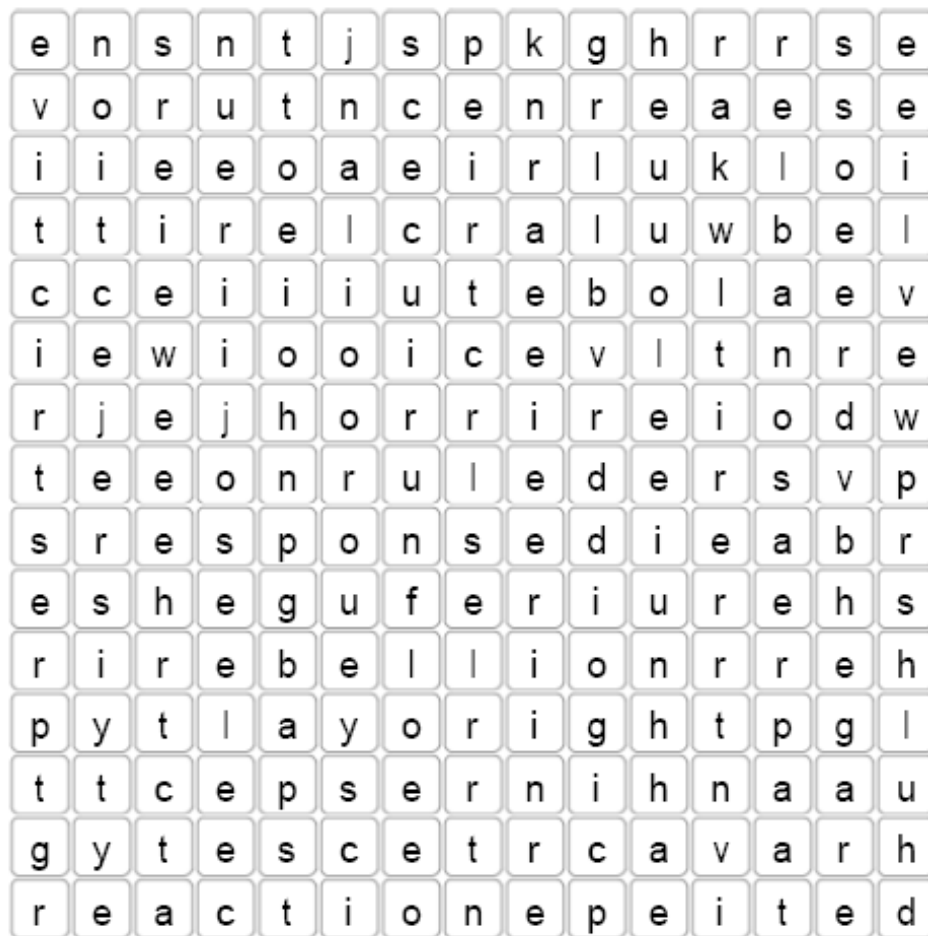
Finish your time by saying the Psalm together out loud.
