### Here are some questions for Life groups on John 3:19-21...

1) What are the two reasons that people don't come to Jesus and even "hate" Jesus, the light (v20)? How have you seen this in your own experience (either in evangelism or in your own story)?

2) The ESV version for v21 (slightly more literal) reads: "But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God." What difference at this time should it make to our a) outreach, b) our love for our neighbour c) our fight against sin, that our works are ultimately a work of God.
