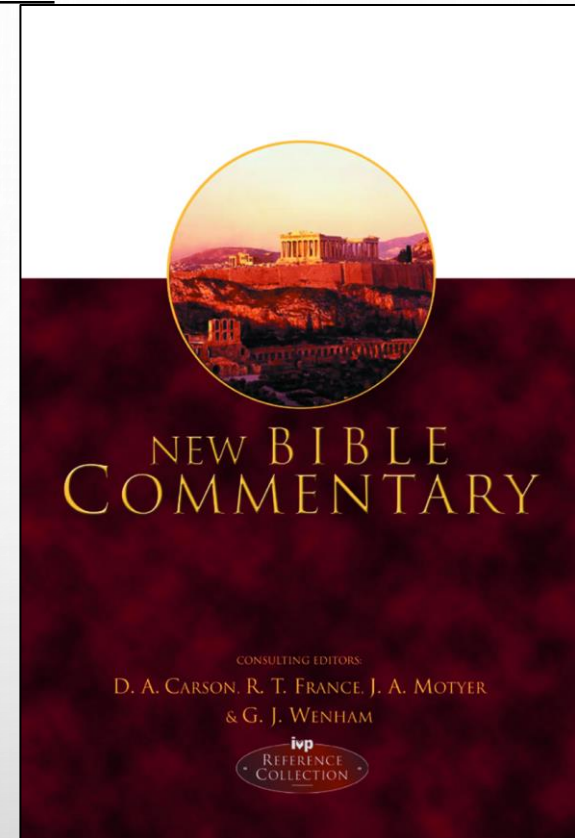

"Many view questioning God as sinful, but Habakkuk and Job show this is not so. Rough passages in life can produce honest doubt and perplexity, and God condemns neither Job nor Habakkuk for expressing these doubts.

While an answer might not come immediately, or might itself cause consternation, God does not ban honest questioning".

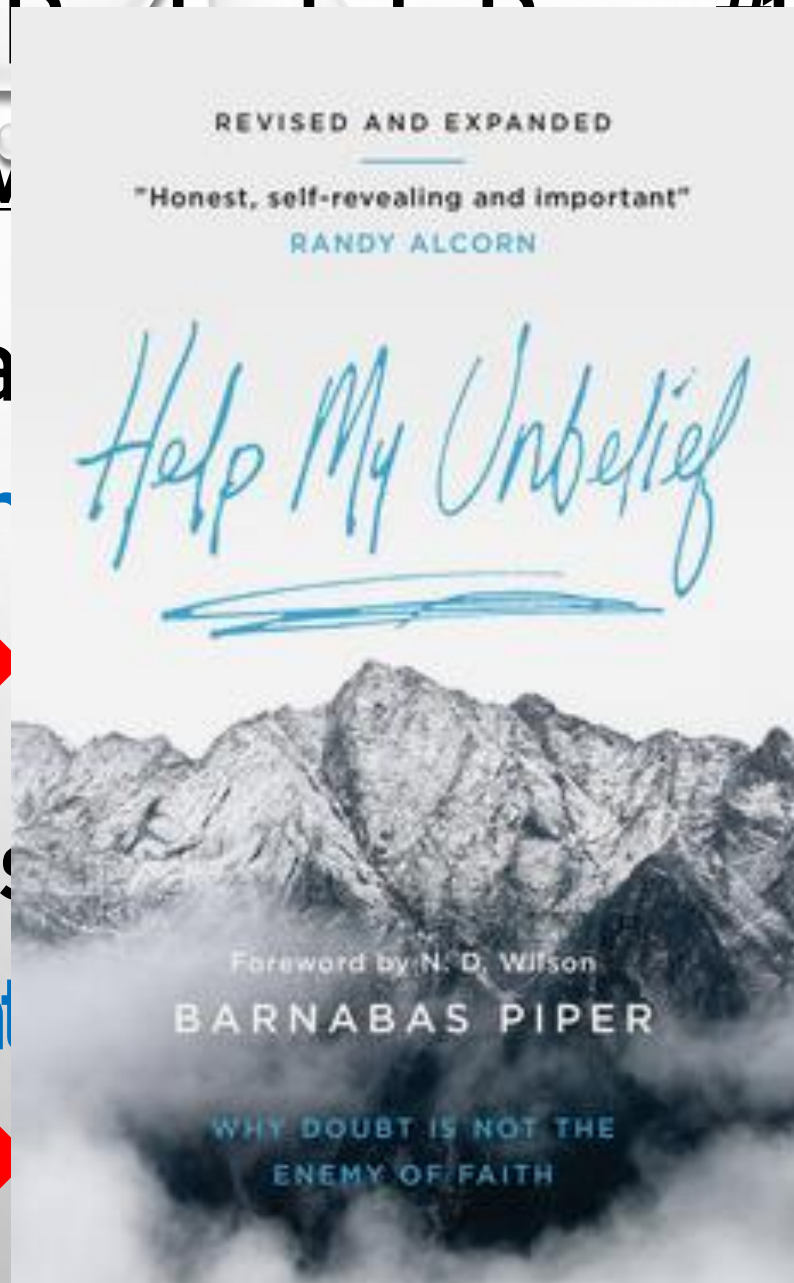
