
Dig Deeper Topic: The Tongue - A Fire **Verses:** Proverbs 10:18-32, James 3:1-12

- 1. Looking at Proverbs 10:19-21, and 32, what are the main contrasts between the righteous and the foolish?
- 2. What does Proverbs 10:18-21 say about the heart? (You can also use Matthew 15:18, and Luke 6:45 to help.)
- 3. In light of the answers from the previous question, how do you think this image could be applied?



- 4. Since death and life are in the power of the tongue (Proverbs 18:21), how might this impact relationships (peers, enemies, and those we influence)? (Proverbs 15:4)
- 5. Can we give any examples of what the first part of Proverbs 10:20 looks like? "*The tongue of the righteous is choice silver, but the heart of the wicked is of little value.*" (Try taking a look at Proverbs 12:18 too).
- 6. How can we apply the teaching of these in our lives?

Things to consider

- 1. Pray and ask Jesus to help you this week as you walk out in faith trusting He will help you by The Holy Spirit.
- 2. Prayerfully seek to be accountable with your words this week in one or two areas that you struggle in the most.
