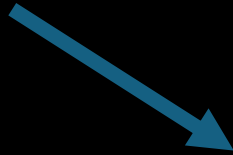
Jesus came and stood among them  
and said, '**Peace** be with you!'

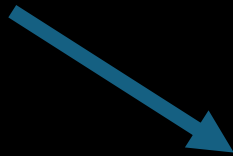
# Purpose (21b)
